The Foundation shares the District's vision to focus on programs that help students reach their potential and positively impact the future.

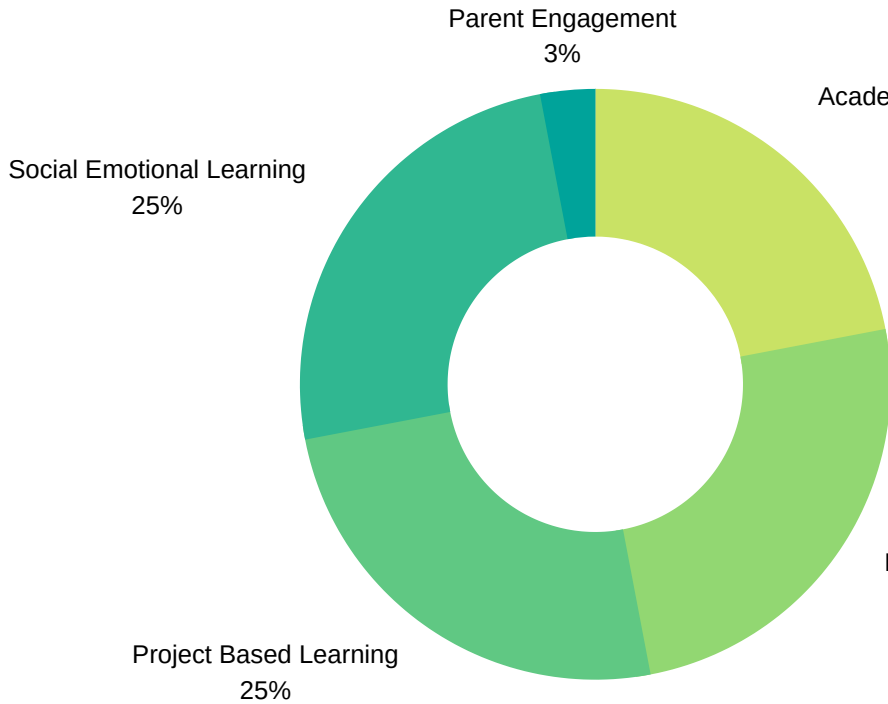

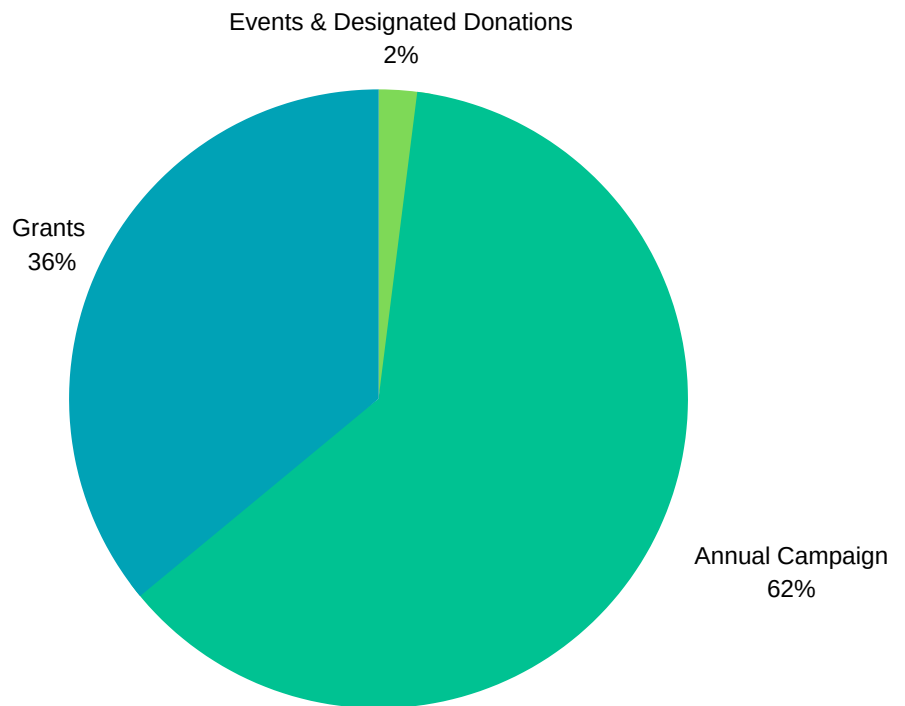
